It is our honor and privilege to invite you to our forthcoming Fourth International Reunion to be held on February 1, 2014 at the Manila Hotel at One Rizal Park, 0913, Manila Philippines.

Every two years, the CLSU International Alumni Association organizes a Grand International Reunion in Las Vegas, Nevada, USA. For the next Reunion, however, the Board of Directors of the CLSUIAA decided to host it in Manila, Philippines to kick-start the year-long 50th Anniversary Celebration of the elevation of CLSU from its humble beginnings as a school and college.

As directed by the Board, we will assess US\$100 to those residing outside the Philippines, to subsidize the Php 1000 peso tickets that will be sold to local alumni. For every \$100 collected from expatriate alumni and friends, we will be able to offer 2 tickets at a 50% discount to local alumni.
