The Central Luzon State University International Alumni Association, Inc. (CLSUIAA) is embarking on a new project during the first part of 2016 called Humanitarian, Medical, Dental and Optical (HMDO) Mission. Specifically, the Mission will be conducted at CLSU campus to serve primarily the underprivileged residents of the neighboring Barangays at CLSU which may include, but not limited to, Bagong Sicat, Bantug, Santo Tomas and others. The HMDO Mission will be held shortly after the CLSU Grand Alumni Homecoming on February 5-7, 2016. The Mission is tentatively scheduled on Monday, February 8, 2016.

The HMDO Mission at CLSU will be jointly sponsored primarily by the San Diego County Metropolitan Lions Club (SDMLC), CLSU International Alumni Association, Inc., and the CLSU-Alumni Relations Office (ARO). Supportive roles will also be provided by the CLSU Alumni Association, Inc. (CLSUAAI) and the CLSU Alumni Foundation, Inc. (CAFI).

During the event, free medical consultations, dental examinations and extractions, diabetes tests to determine incidence of diabetes, and optical services will be offered. Free medicines will also be dispensed and reading glasses for the preservation of sight will be distributed to clients. In addition, there is going to be a feeding program for children. We are anticipating that approximately 1,000 clients will be served coming mostly from Barangays surrounding CLSU. The HMDO Mission will be staffed by volunteer doctors, nurses, technicians and support personnel provided locally and from the USA. Our goal is to raise \$2,500 or more to support this great endeavor at CLSU to provide the humanitarian, medical, dental and optical services.

To date, we have received from over a dozen generous CLSUIAA officers and supporters who donated an amount ranging from \$20 to \$500 each with a total donation amounting to \$2,560. As you can see, we barely made our goal. We also need to build some cushion for any contingencies that may arise. It is for this reason that I am sending this solicitation letter to please consider donating for this cause. Any amount that will not used for the HMDO Mission will be allocated to the Association's Scholarship fund as recently approved by the Executive Committee. If you have already responded to this solicitation, please ignore this letter and thank you for your generosity.

We firmly believe that the HMDO Mission at CLSU will somehow be able to ameliorate temporarily the health and suffering of many poor and underprivileged people in the Philippines, particularly in the targeted areas of our Mission. We have established a Humanitarian Fund and donations will be used entirely for this purpose. Your generosity will help us reach our goal.
