To All members of Association,

Knowing the urgency of the help needed, Rob called an emergency virtual BOD meeting at 8PM on 03April2020 via Video Chat on Messenger.

Discussion focused on how the association can help the 262 trapped students remaining in CLSU during the Covid-19 Philippine government's mandated Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ).

Th meeting initially started on the messenger video chat app, - but technical difficulties have risen such as echo, sound delays, etc., coming from different speakers that communications became incoherent. It was decided that the app be closed and finish off the discussions on messenger via text messaging.

During text messaging, the discussion revolved only on how much monetary assistance will be granted to augment the support given by the local government assistance program. It was understood that money will be allocated from a portion of net proceeds earned from the February 9th, 2020 Quest Event Registration.

Members present voted 6 to 4 in favor of giving out \$1000 assistance to the "Cause: Donation Relief Effort to Covid-19 stranded CLSU students".
