Special Educational Projects

- Student Research Project -Jemimah Olo recently submitted a report of her student research project entitled "Pulverized Ceramic Riles Residue as Partial Substitution to Fine Aggregates in Brick Fabrication: A Sustainable Management of Construction Waste Material." This project was completed with two other students. Jemimah was awarded \$125 per her requests for financial assistance under our Special Education Project/Program. ACTIONS NEEDED:

- Discuss the request of Jemimah Olo for financial assistance in taking review class for the Civil Engineering Board Exam and decide to grant or not to grant the request.
- Discuss the approved policy of giving financial gift/incentive to graduating scholars who were given scholastic honors by the University (i.e. cum laude) and make decision.
- Recommend that we increase our GSP grant from \$400 to \$450 per year. We generally adjust our grant due to inflation, etc.
- Recommend that we provide scholarship grants to 4 new scholars to start in SY23-24 replacing the 4 scholars who recently graduated.
