De Vera volunteered to compile a list of interesting places with the respective prices that attendees can see so a decision can be made in the next meeting if CLSUIAA will sponsor a group tour as a pre-post 2016 Homecoming activity based from the interest /commitment generated by this listing.

because all the required documentation (forms) were not submitted and since the deadline is November 30, 2015, there is no more time to prepare these for this year. **Ms. Gloria De Vera** informed the Executive Committee that the deadline was extended to Dec. 15, 2015, so if the problem is time to prepare the forms, there is ample time left to prepare and follow the established and approved SEA process in the recommendation of awards to the **CLSUAAI Board of Directors.**
