
May the success of this program deepen the relationship between the Administration and CLSUIAAI and inspire us all to collaborate more for the development of the CLSU Community.

Terminal Report on International Alumni Student Adoption Program (i-ASAP)

Introduction

In the academe, no face-to-face classes and asynchronous modes of learning were sought to continue the learning of our students. However, not all students can adopt this new normal due to resource constraints such as limited internet data and lack of financial support. These deeply affect the academic performance of the students which may result in dropping out of the course or lower grades.

Hence, this program was proposed to the CLSU International Alumni Association, Inc. to seek short-term financial support (Php 2,500.00) for our enrolled students to augment their internet and/or other academic expenses. This adoption program commenced last AY 2020-2021 2nd Semester.

Application and Requirements

The information was given to the University Supreme Student Council and recognized student organizations. The applicants were asked to fill out the Google Form, upload the screenshots of Form 6 & Certificate of Grades from the CLSU Portal and upload two to three-minute video to introduce themselves, the family background, hobbies, and interests, course taken, intended expenditures and why they deserve to be the beneficiary of the stipend.

Mechanics of the Program

1. The CLSU Alumni Relations Office, in cooperation with the CLSU University Supreme Student Council and Student Organizations Unit, screened the applicants and shortlisted forty-five (45) students.
2. The shortlisted students, together with their records, were forwarded to the BOD-CLSU International Alumni Association, Inc. for their approval.
3. Upon approval of the application, the CLSU International Alumni Association sent to the CLSU Alumni Relations office the official list of the beneficiaries and transferred the fund to the authorized personnel/individual account. *The CLSUIAAI requested that the remittance must be sent to a personal account to lessen the transaction cost, as compared to remittance to an institutional account.*
4. The CLSU Alumni Relations Office facilitated the communication between the CLSUIAAI benefactors and beneficiaries through Google Classroom and Facebook Messenger Group Chat. See Appendix A and Appendix B.
5. Proof of receipts were uploaded to the assigned Google Classroom of the beneficiaries.

Number of Beneficiaries

There were forty-five (45) students who were chosen, participated and benefited on this program. List of student beneficiaries were shown at Appendix C.

Total Amount of Program

The program was totally valued at Php 112,500.00. For the next five months (March – July 2021), the short-term financial assistance of Php 500.00 was remitted to the registered G-Cash number of the student beneficiary.

Activities Conducted


- Zoomustahan events were conducted as a tribute of our CLSU student-beneficiaries to their international alumni-benefactors. There were two Zoomustahan activities such as Easter Day Special last 04 April 2021 and Independence Day Special last 04 July 2021. See Appendix D.
- Google Classroom was launched to serve as a platform for both the benefactor and beneficiary to exchange information related to dreamboard, video and receipts of remittances. See Appendix E and Appendix F for the sample dreamboards and sample receipts.
- Chat Group was created for the immediate exchange of messages between the alumni and the student. It is also a medium for the closer interaction of the benefactor and beneficiary.






